ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973.

Whereas, it has been made to appear that Novel Corona virus – known as n COVID-19 continues to spread in the country which is very dangerous to human life. As of now, vaccine of the same has not been formulated. As such there is likelihood of breach of peace and tranquillity on account of n COVID-19.

And whereas I am satisfied that immediate measures are needed to be taken to prevent such danger to human health and safety of general public on account of spread of n COVID-19

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of code of Criminal procedure, 1973. I, Mukul Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate Yamuna Nagar do hereby prohibit the assembly of twenty or more than twenty people in public places. It must also be ensured that Social distancing norms circulated by Ministry of Health and family welfare (MoHFW) in Govt. of India are followed, in case the assembly is of less than twenty persons. Further guidelines of Quarantine/ Isolation and identity of persons who have travel history of abroad shall be strictly followed. These orders shall not be applicable in case of Bus Stands, Railway Stations, Hospitals, Banks, Post Offices, Government Enterprises, Public Offices, Industrial and Commercial Establishments, Police and Public servants on duty.

Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, Sub Divisional Magistrates, All Executive Magistrates, All Deputy Superintendent of Police and All SHOs shall be responsible for

enforcement of above prohibitory orders in its letters and spirit.

This order shall be applicable in Yamuna Nagar District and shall be promulgated in the area of district Yamuna Nagar by beat of drum, by announcement through the publicity van of Public Relation Department and by affixing of the copies of this order on the notice boards of District Courts/ Sub Division/ Tehsil Courts/ Police Stations and at conspicuous places of the District Yamuna Nagar.

In view of the requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order is

assed emplace and is addressed to the public at large.

The violation of this order is punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
