ORDER

The world health organization has declared COVID 19 as global pandemic and the National Disaster Management Authority is satisfied that the country is threatened with the spread of COVID 19 epidemic and has considered it necessary to take effective measures to prevent its spread across the country. In compliance with the orders issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India Order No.40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) dated 17.05.2020, Lockdown measures will continue for a period up to 31-05-2020 in the territorial jurisdiction of Haryana. Accordingly, to contain the transmission of nCOVID-19 disease, following orders under sections 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 are hereby made to regulate the operations of the activities in the territorial jurisdiction of the district Yamuna Nagar.

The following activities shall continue to remain prohibited for the period of two weeks with effect from 18.05.2020.

- i. All international air travel of passengers, Metro Rail Services.
- ii All schools, Colleges, educational/training/coaching institutions etc. However, online/distance learning shall be permitted.
- iii. Hotels, Restaurants and other Hospitality services other than those used for housing health/police/Government Officials/healthcare workers, stranded persons including tourists and those used for quarantine facilities.
- iv. All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.
 - v. All social/political/sports/entertainment/academic/cultural/religious functions/ other gatherings and large congregation.
 - vi. All religious places/places of worship shall be closed for public, religious congregations are strictly prohibited.

However, only essential activities shall be allowed in Containment Zones.

As per National Directives for nCOVID-19 management, the following are the lockdown measures to be complied by public and work places-

Measures at Work Place

- Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all work places and adequate stock of such face covers shall be made available.
- ii. All persons in charge of work places shall ensure social distancing through adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, both within the work places and in company transport.
- iii. Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer preferably with touch free mechanism will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas. In addition, sufficient quantities of handwash and sanitizer shall be made available in the work places.
- iv. Frequent sanitization of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. door handles etc., shall be ensured, including between shifts
- v. Use of Arogya Setu app shall be made mandatory for all employees, both private and public. It shall be the responsibility of the Head of the respective organizations to ensure 100% coverage of this app among the employees.

Measures at Public Places:

- Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all public places. i.
- ii. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years shall stay at home, except for meeting essential requirements and for health purposes.
 - All persons in charge of public places and transport shall ensure social distancing iii. as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- Marriages related gatherings shall ensure social distancing and the maximum iv. number of guests allowed shall not be more than 50.
- Funeral/last rites related gatherings shall ensure social distancing, and the V. maximum numbers allowed shall not be more than 20.
- Spitting in public places shall be punishable with fine and consumption of liquor, vi. pan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places is not allowed.
- Public is advised to install the Arogya Setu mobile App on their mobile phone and regularly update their health status on the same.

All establishments shall ensure permanent paint marking outside and inside their premises. These marks shall be made 1m apart and it shall be ensured that persons visiting and working maintain social distancing by means of those marks. They shall also ensure that no vehicle is parked outside their shops so as to allow enough space for people to stand as per markings.

All the concerned are hereby ordered to comply with the directions above. Any violation of these instructions/orders is liable to criminal prosecution under section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.
