

## OFFICE OF DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, YAMUNA NAGAR

### ORDER

Whereas nCOVID-19 has been declared as a pandemic by the World Health Organization and National Disaster Management Authority has declared lockdown in the entire country. In compliance with the orders issued by the Govt. of Haryana from time to time, the orders of the lockdown have been issued in the territorial jurisdiction of district Yamuna Nagar.

In continuation of this office letter No. 1340/MA dated 24.03.2020, order No. 1432/MA dated 31.03.2020, order No. 1662/MA dated 15.04.2020 and letter No.1871/MA dated 03.05.2020 and in compliance with the orders issued by the Govt. of Haryana vide letter No.DMC-SPO-2020/5339 dated 01.05.2020 and by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India Order No.40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) dated 01.05.2020 and to contain the transmission of nCOVID-19 disease, the orders under sections 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 are hereby made to regulate the operations of the activities in the territorial jurisdiction of the district Yamuna Nagar, which are summarized as:

1. The following activities will continue to remain prohibited for the period of two weeks with effect from 04.05.2020.
  - i. All domestic and international air travel of passengers, except for medical services, air ambulance and for security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
  - ii. All passenger movement by trains, except for security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
  - iii. Inter-State Buses for public transport, except as permitted by MHA.
  - iv. Metro rail services.
  - v. Inter-state movement of individuals except for medical reasons or for activities as permitted by MHA.
  - vi. All schools, Colleges, educational/training/coaching institutions etc. However, online/distance learning shall be permitted.
  - vii. Hospitality services other than those used for housing health/police/Government Officials/healthcare workers, stranded persons including tourists and those used for quarantine facilities.
  - viii. All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, sports complexes, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.

- ix. All social/political/sports/entertainment/academic/cultural/religious functions/ other gatherings.
- x. All religious places/places of worship shall be closed for public, religious congregations are strictly prohibited.

As per National Directives for nCOVID-19 management, the following are the lockdown measures to be complied by public and work places-

#### **Measures at Work Place**

- i. Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all work places and adequate stock of such face covers shall be made available.
- ii. All persons in charge of work places shall ensure social distancing as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, both within the work places and in company transport.
- iii. Social distancing at work places shall be ensured through adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.
- iv. Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer preferably with touch free mechanism will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas. In addition, sufficient quantities of handwash and sanitizer shall be made available in the work places.
- v. Frequent sanitization of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. door handles etc., shall be ensured, including between shifts.
- vi. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years shall stay at home, except for meeting essential requirements and for health purposes.
- vii. Use of *Arogya Setu* app shall be made mandatory for all employees, both private and public. It shall be the responsibility of the Head of the respective organizations to ensure 100% coverage of this app among the employees.
- viii. Arrangements for transport facilities shall be ensured with social distancing, wherever personal/public transport is not feasible.

#### **Measures at Public Places:**

- i. Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all public places.
- ii. All persons in charge of public places and transport shall ensure social distancing as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- iii. No organization/ manager of public place shall allow gathering of 5 or more persons.
- iv. Marriages related gatherings shall ensure social distancing and the maximum number of guests allowed shall not be more than 50.
- v. Funeral/last rites related gatherings shall ensure social distancing, and the maximum numbers allowed shall not be more than 20.

- vi. Spitting in public places shall be punishable with fine, as may be prescribed by the State/Ut local authority.
- vii. Consumption of liquor, pan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places is not allowed.
- viii. Shops selling liquor, pan, gutka, tobacco etc. will ensure minimum six feet distance (2 gaz ki doori) from each other, and also ensure that no more than 5 persons are present at one time at the shop.

All establishments shall ensure permanent paint marking outside and inside their premises. These marks shall be made 1m apart and it shall be ensured that persons visiting and working maintain social distancing by means of those marks. They shall also ensure that no vehicle is parked outside their shops so as to allow enough space for people to stand as per markings.

All the concerned are hereby ordered to comply with the directions above. Any violation of these instructions/orders is liable to criminal prosecution under section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.
